STAGE 3: HOGAN'S ALLEY

SCENARIO

The Special Police School was established at Camp Perry as a joint venture between the US Army and the NRA, after a 1920 survey of metropolitan police departments found that very few agencies had a formal marksmanship training program. World War II saw the closure of the school, but the concepts taught there lived on through the war in the training of OSS agents, and still today in modern police training.

The FBI operates the modern Hogan's Alley, which has evolved into a 10-acre simulated town. The facility serves as a training ground for use of force, counter-terrorism, crime scene investigation, warrant service, and more.

Round Count: 22P Start Position:

Pistol: Loaded, holstered

Shooter: Standing at either Position A or B, facing up-range (away from targets).

Setup:

Shooter will enter start position and make ready, then face up-range. Afterwards, three random targets that the shooter doesn't have sight of will be made into no-shoot targets. The three targets should not all be visible from the same shooting position, and should be different for each shooter. **Shooter shall not be told where the no-shoot targets are located.**


Procedure:

At start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area. All shoot targets require two hits each.

Shoot targets: Guns and knives

No-shoot targets: Empty hands, guns with badges
